

McKENZIE MUNICIPAL REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

I. Call to Order/Establishment of a Quorum

Meeting was called to order by Chairperson Robb and a quorum was established. Commissioner Hawkins was absent.

State Planner Merrill stated that the discussion of the Institution District(s) had been introduced out of the order in the commission's preparation and completion of the overall comprehensive plan for the city. A motion was made by Commissioner Dillon and seconded by Commissioner Priestley to table the presentation to a future date. The motion passed.
